The sea is becoming a very crowded space.

People want to use the sea to transport people and goods, to produce energy, to catch fish, and to conserve nature.



Think about how these competing uses of the sea might interact.

If we make all of Scotland's waters Marine Protected Areas, how will fishermen fish? If we continue to use the seas as a site to produce energy and to transport goods globally, how will pollution affect the creatures that live there?

Can all of these uses sit alongside each other? Who should decide which is the most important use of the sea?
